Critical Failure Criteria

- _____ Failure to initiate or call for transport of the patient within 10 minute time limit.
- _____ Failure to take or verbalize body substance isolation precautions.
- _____ Failure to determine scene safety.
- _____ Failure to assess for and provide spinal protection when indicated.
- _____ Failure to voice and ultimately provide high concentration oxygen.
- _____ Failure to find or appropriately manage problems associated with airway, breathing, hemorrhage, or shock (hypoperfusion).
- _____ Failure to differentiate patient's immediate need for transportation vs. continued assessment and treatment at the scene.
- _____ Carries out other detailed/focused history or physical exam prior to assessing, and treating threats to airway, breathing, and circulation.
- _____ Orders inappropriate or dangerous interventions.

Must score > 44 to collect 80%, < 44 = Failure

* Indicates an automatic failure.
